GETTING TO UNIVERSITY OF DEUSTO/ FOUNDATION OF DEUSTO

By plane. From Bilbao Airport.

Bilbao Airport (which international code is BIO) is also known as Loiu Airport or simply “La Paloma”. After taking your baggage at the Airport Terminal (if you travel from country that are not member of EU, your baggage carousel is No 6 or 7 – Annex 2), follow the EXIT indications. Once outside, you have two options: you can take a taxi OR the Airport bus.

Taxi. The transfer from the airport to Deusto University takes around 10- 15 minutes. Standard fare is around 25€. You will see the taxi stop after the Exit doors on the left side. Please type the address of your destination before the trip, since most taxi drivers are not speak English.

Airport Bus [A3247]. It is a good option. The ticket bus costs 1,45 € one way. You will see the Bus stop after the Exit door on the right side (Annex 2). Bus (A3247 BILBAO-Airport) operates every day, with services every 20 minutes in summer (Bilbao-Airport from 05:20 to 22:00 and Airport –Bilbao from 06:20 to 00:00), and 30 minutes in the winter season (Bilbao-Airport from 05:25 to 21:55 and Airport –Bilbao from 06:15 to 00:00), connecting with TERMIBUS.

.Before reaching the end of the route, the bus makes three stops (Annex 3) in the city centre:

- 14 Alameda Rekalde (closest to the UD),
- Plaza Moyúa,
- 79 Gran Vía.

NOTE: For public transportation you need cash (EUR)

Walk till your Hotel (Annex 4). Check the map for more indications.

By bus. From Bilbao Termibus (Bus Station).

You can take a taxi (10 €, aprox.), the streetcar (get off at “Abandoibarra”, near Zubiarte Commercial Center) or the Metro (get off at “Deusto” Station).

By train. From RENFE Bilbao-Abando (Train Station).

You can take a taxi (10 €, aprox.), the streetcar (take it at C/ Navarra -“Abando” Stop- and get off at “Abandoibarra”, near Zubiarte Commercial Center) or the Metro (inside the Train Station, take the Metro at “Abando” Station and get off at “Deusto” Station).

By car.

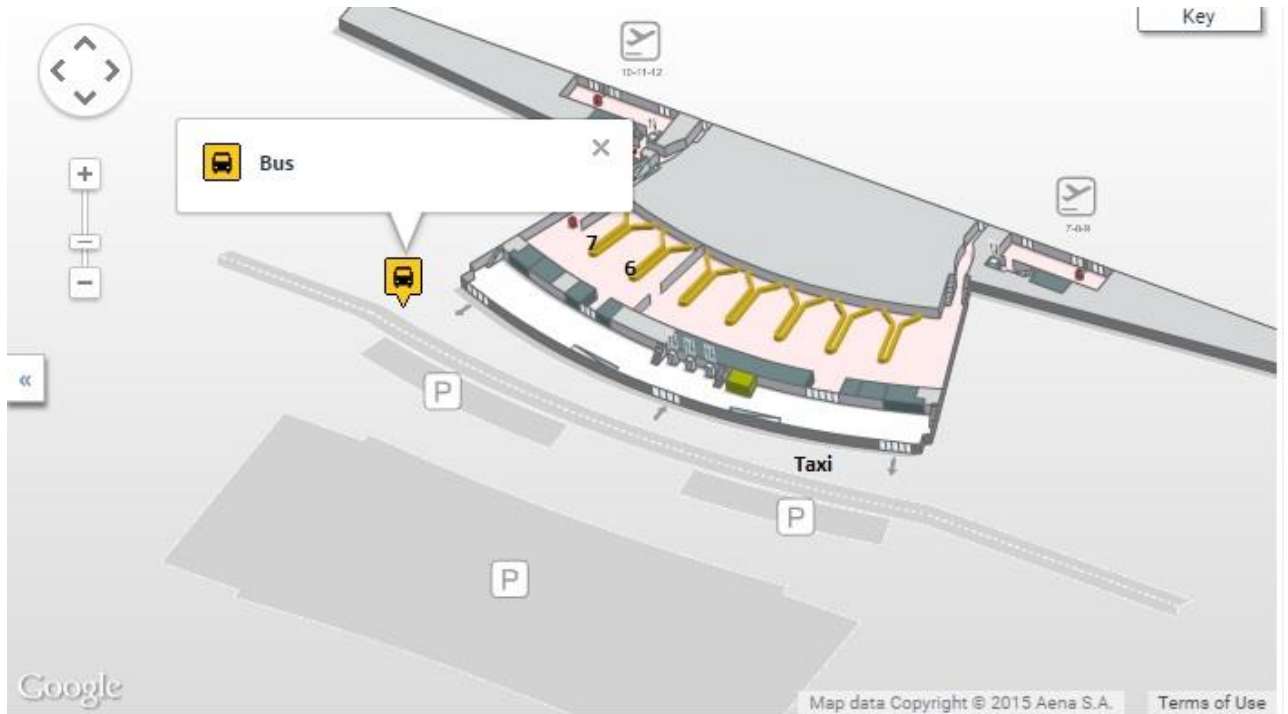

Annex 1 (Campus Plan)



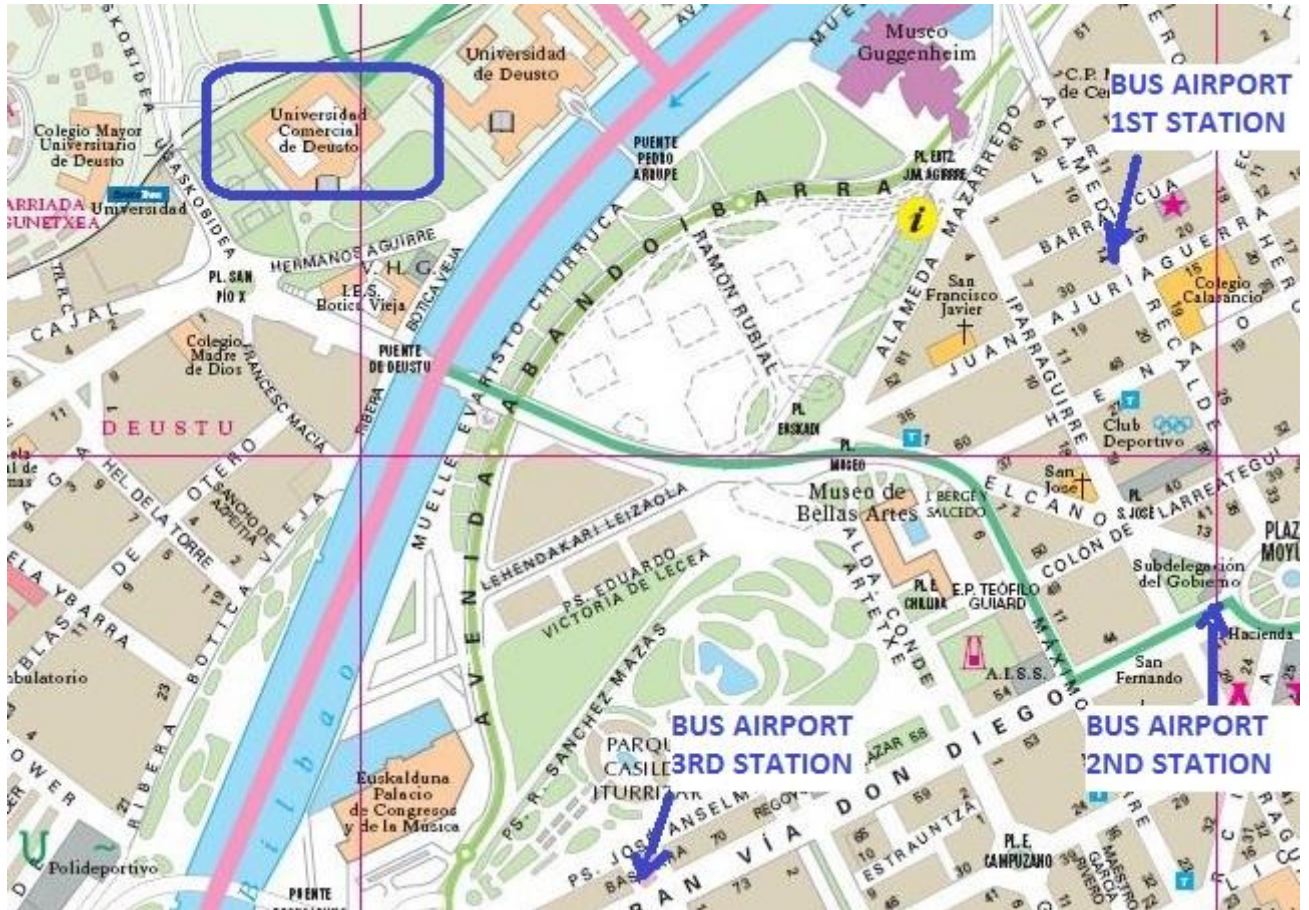

Annex 3 (Airport Bus Stations)

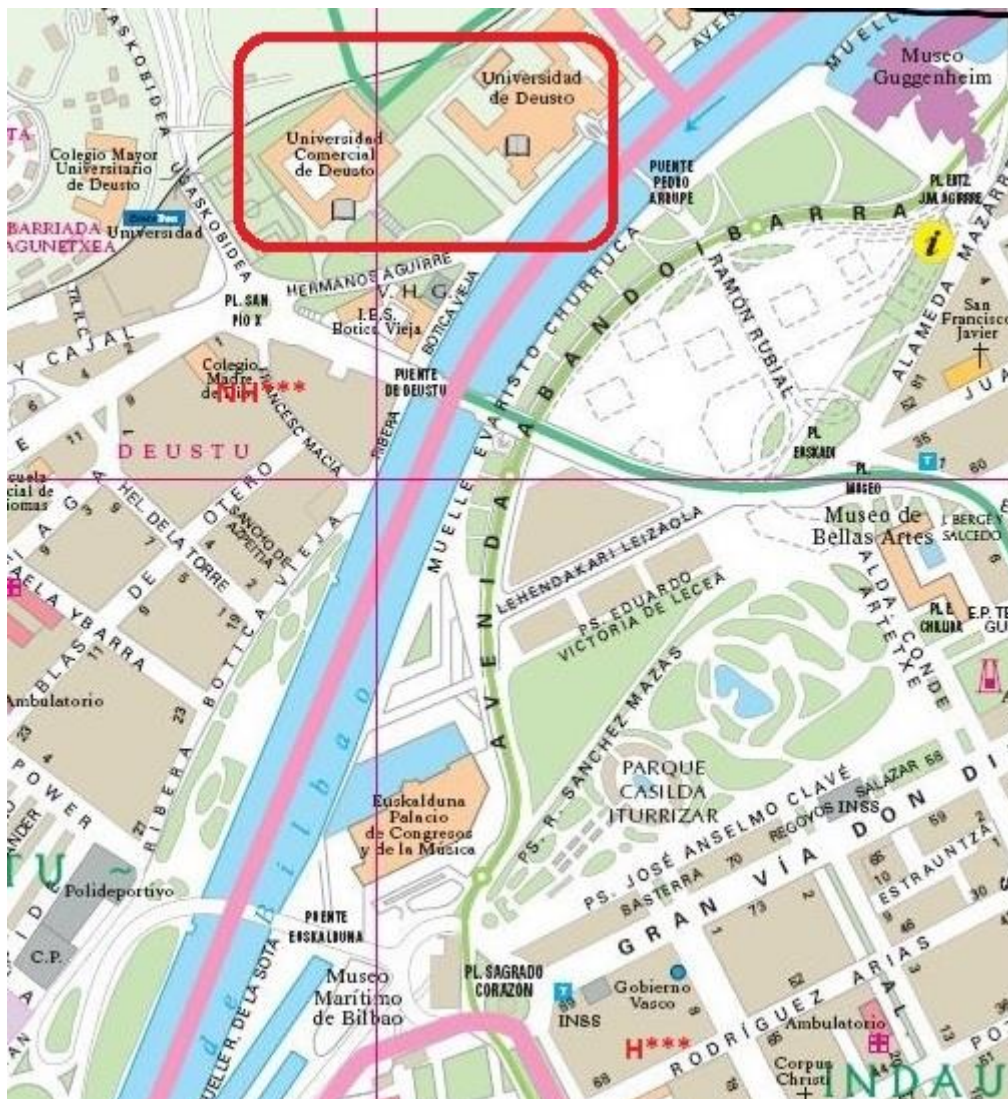
